

Response 4: Enrollment and Attendance

4a. Enrollment

Anticipated effects on student enrollment given the in-person and remote learning plans the charter has in place for the 2020-2021 school year;

The evidence and information the education corporation will collect that corroborates and justifies the student enrollment count the education corporation will use for billing during the 2020-2021 school year; and, identify touch points with families and students, and the evidence the education corporation/school is or will collect to support the enrollment count and who at the education corporation is responsible for ensuring accuracy and documentation collection.

It is anticipated from parent surveys conducted in June that approximately 20 % of our families may choose to go fully remote. This percentage may shift depending on the rate of infection in the state in late August and families' individual circumstances. A survey will be sent out in early August asking families to make a final selection between fully remote and the hybrid model.

The evidence ACS will collect to corroborate student enrollment will be the following:

- Student time logged into a learning platform and submitted work products;
- Student attendance during live instruction;
- Student in-person attendance [for hybrid model]; and
- Phone call corroborating student attendance weekly with remote learners.

The operations staff at each school is responsible for documentation collection on a daily basis, and routine reporting. The Network Director of Operations and Chief Finance and Administration Officer ensure the data collected and reported is accurate.
